See you at the November meeting.

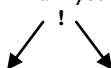

Wounded Warrior Project

The WWP exists to honor and empower Wounded Warriors who incurred wounds, injuries, or illnesses on or after September 11, 2011. Programs serve warriors with every type of injury, from the physical to the invisible wounds of war. 48,000+ service members have been physically injured in recent military conflicts; another 320,000 have experienced a traumatic brain injury while on deployment; and as many as 4000,000 additional service members live with invisible sounds of war including combat-related stress, major depression and post-traumatic brain disorder. 82.8% of money collected goes to the Project; 4.3% for administration and 12.8% for advertising and promotions.

A Warning About 1995-1999 Buicks

For all owners of 1995-1999 Buick Riviera, LeSabre and Park Avenue models with 3.8 engines: At the rear of the sub-frame area, the drain hole is too high, thus allowing water to collect in the sub-frame. This could result in the inner frame rusting away, which can be as dangerous as it is costly to repair. If you own one of these cars, you should have it checked by a reputable mechanic.
