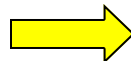
## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

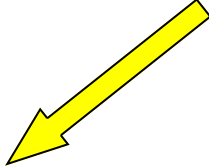

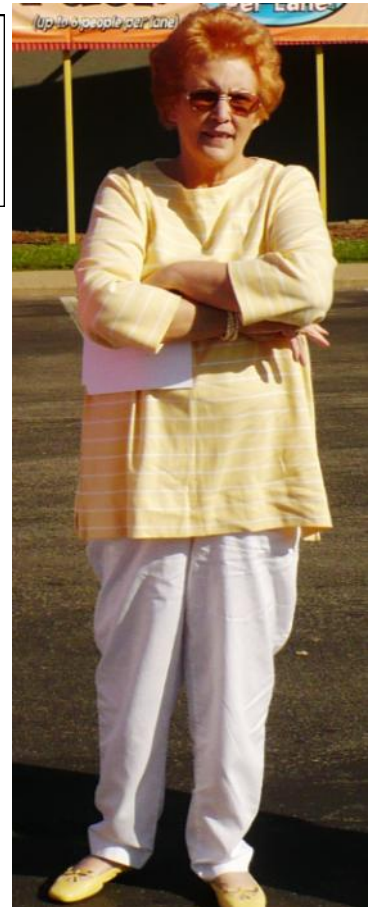
Patty Illsley

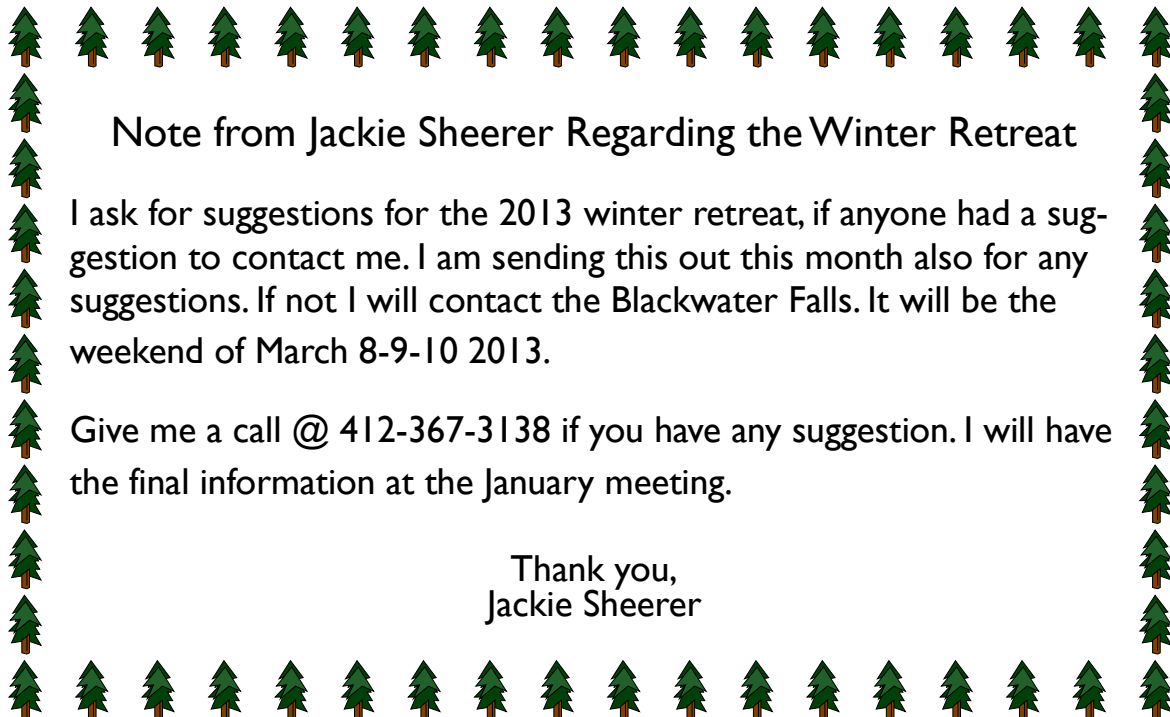
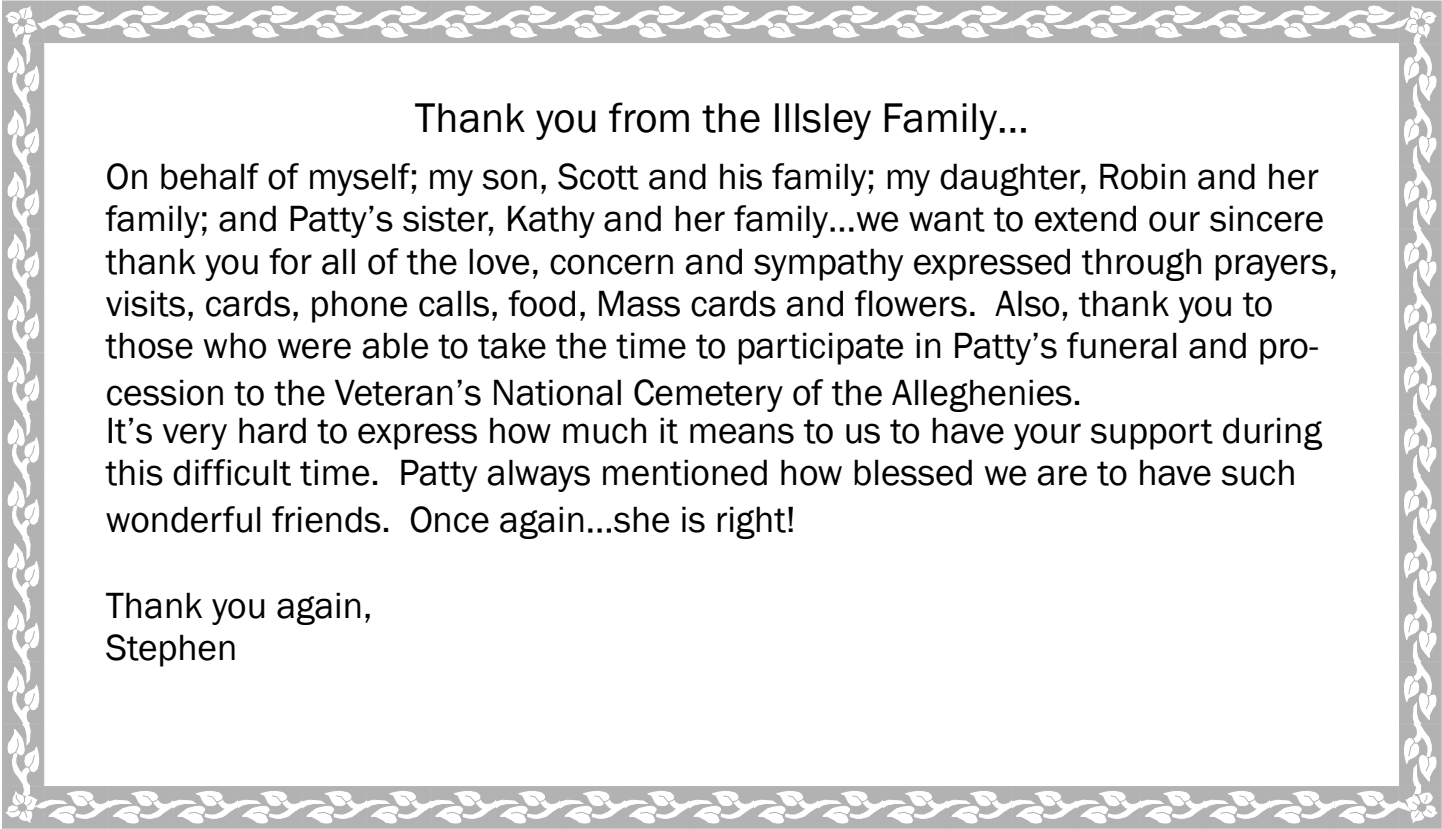
