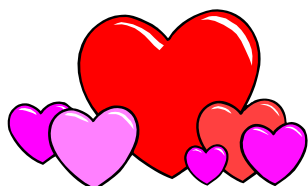

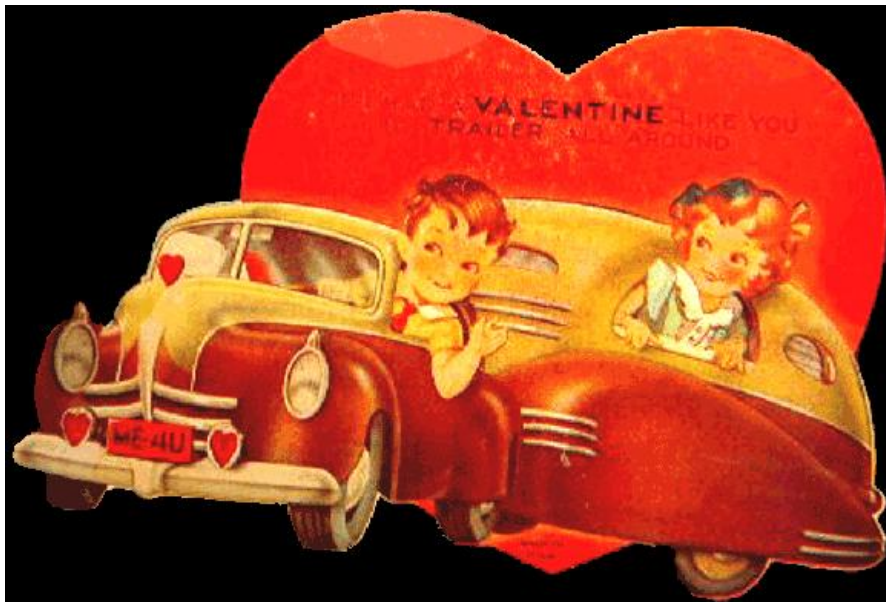

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR OLDER CARS

The American Automobile Association is calling for the EPA and gasoline retailers to suspend the sale of E15 gasoline (15% ethanol) until more information is known about its effects on older cars, and until safeguards are in place to avoid drivers mistakenly putting the E15 blend in cars which may be damaged by it. The EPA, which approved its sale earlier this year, recommends E15 for flexible-fuel vehicles and certain cars made 2001 or later. The AAA's concern is that owners of cars not suitable for E15 may mistakenly fill their cars with the blend. It is currently being sold in only a few states.
