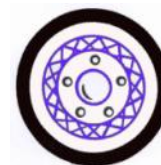

Are you paying for "stacked" insurance coverage but not getting it?

Debby Mueller pointed out a recent court case (Grudkowski v. Foremost Ins. Co., NO. 3; CV-12-1847 M.D. Pa. March 5, 2013) as a basis for asking this question of your insurer. Arlene Grudkowski had separate insurance policies for an antique car, a classic car, and personal cars. She was in an accident which did not involve her antique or classic car, and filed a claim based on the stacked coverage for uninsured and uninsured motorists which was part of the policy she had been paying for several years. Foremost Insurance Co. pointed to a provision in her antique and classic car policies which stated that she or a member of her family had to "occupy" one of those cars in order to receive stacked benefits. The court acknowledged that the insurance company is being paid for "illusory" coverage, but leaves it for the legislature or insurance commissioner to address.

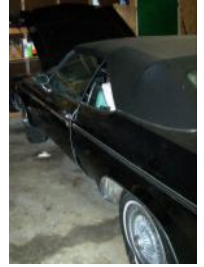
Here's another gem from Joan & Bill Artzberger:
