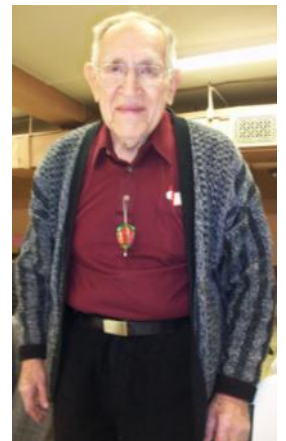
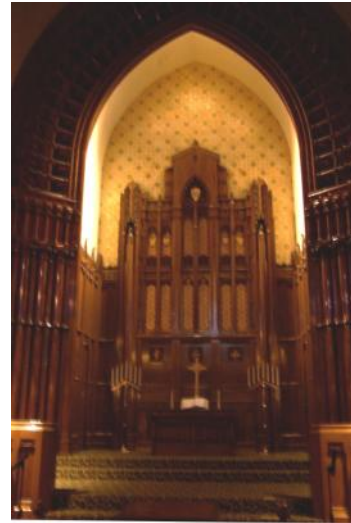

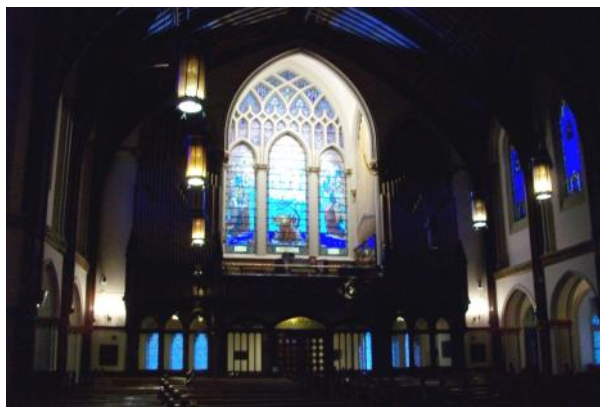
Joan Artzberger greeted everyone with a smile.

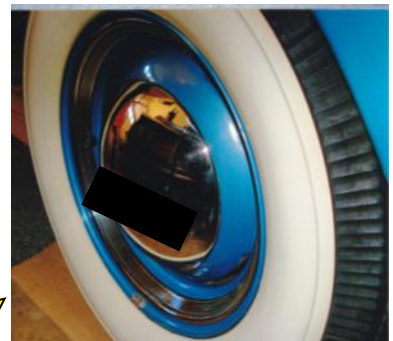
