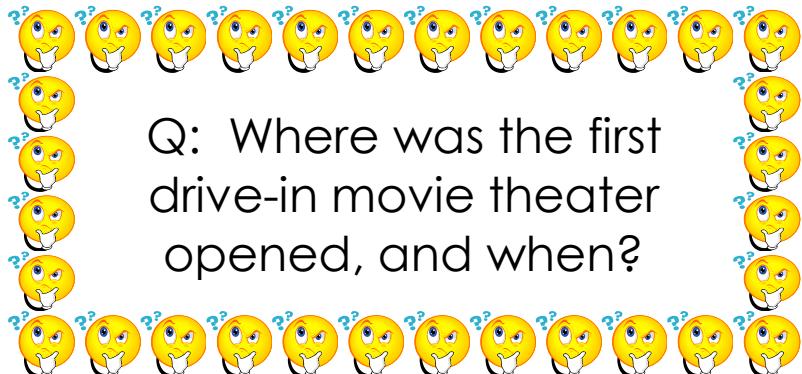

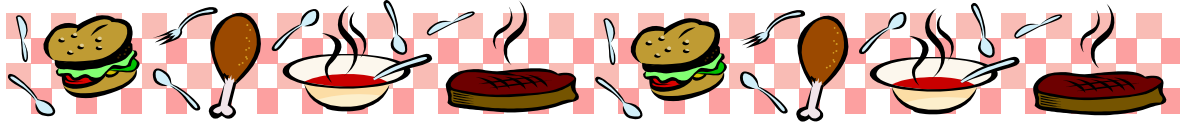

Travel 3.3 miles and turn right on Blakely Road.

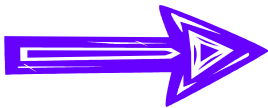
Travel .7 miles and turn left into His Kids School.

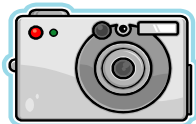
