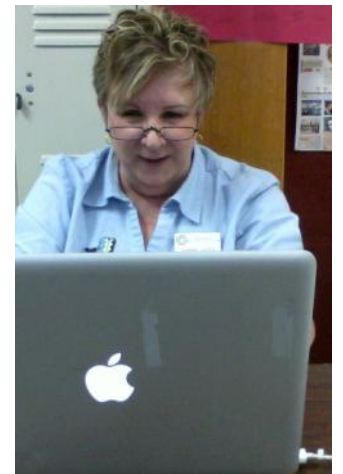
Sunday, July 3 - Meet at St. John's Lutheran Church in Perrysville for Ross Township parade.
