President's Message

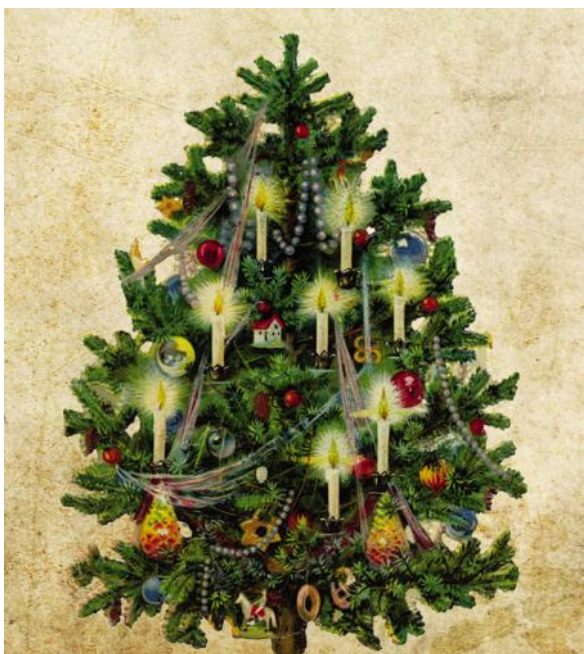

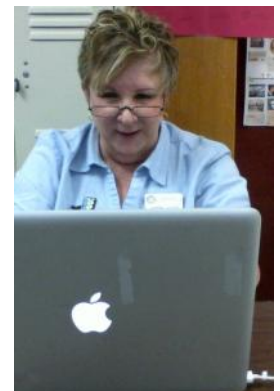
Charitable donations for 2017 will be **It’s About the Warrior Foundation**, a local veterans’ organization, and **North Hills Community Outreach**.

There is an article about the foundation in the July 2, 2016 Pittsburgh Tribune Review (<http://triblive.com/lifestyles/morelifestyles/10627230-74/monteleone-says-sears>) It is a Butler-based foundation, focused on veterans from Western Pennsylvania, Eastern Ohio & Northern West Virginia, founded by Air Force vet Steve Monteleone. Its mission is to help veterans and their families with financial assistance, school tuition, job training, counseling, or just someone to listen. The foundation is four years old, still not big enough to garner a rating at the Charity Navigator website, but big enough to have attracted well-known sponsors from the region. The Pirates worked with Pittsburgh Brewing Co. to produce over 2 million cans of IC Light featuring the It’s About the Warrior Foundation logo, with a portion of the proceeds going to the foundation.

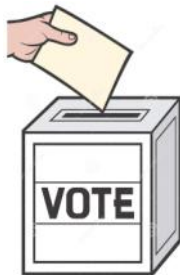

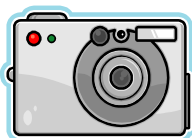
