A Message from the President

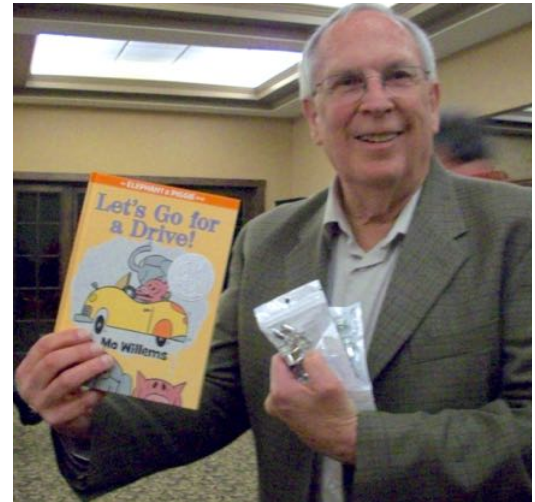
The February Meeting/After Christmas Dinner was a big success! So, on behalf of everyone who attended, we thank Jack and all of his helpers who worked to make it such a good time!
